Château Haut Rozier 2010

Bordeaux-Supérieur



The château Haut Rozier is located in the township of Tayac near Lussac and belongs to the family Laporte since three generations. Nowadays the vineyard is held by Mrs. Pujol, Mister Laporte's daughter. The vinifications are followed by the renowned oenologist: Mister Fakorellis (Malartic Lagravière, Latour Martillac...)

The vinification is traditional; the equipment is modern for this kind of propriety: inokyble stainless tanks and concrete tanks.

Bordeaux Tradition

The color is crimson; the nose of this vintage is jamy, with marqued aromas of ripe red fruits. In the mouth the wine has a fleshy attack and is very think. The tannins are mellow and rich. The final mouth is long with a toasted sensation. This bottle is an enchantment for the pallet and can be drunk straight away or in 5 years.
