## Bordeaux 2012 at Southwold - the left bank

## Saint-Estèphe:

... I was generally very impressed by the consistency and quality of the top names here, with the famous triumvirate Calon-Ségur, Cos d'Estournel and Montrose offering something akin to charm, as did Phélan Ségur, another relative bargain ...

**Château Phélan Ségur 2012 St-Estèphe** - Tasted blind. Lots of glamour and density on the nose with real St-Estèphe integrity too. Round and chock full of St-Estèphe stoniness. Beautiful texture. Should last very well for a 2012 but not as well as other vintages. The most concentrated wine of the Southwold tasting so far (though I have not yet tasted the 2012 Pauillacs). Drink 2022- 2040
