## Vineyard

**Terroir:** Clay-limestone.

**Vineyard area currently in production:** 50 hectares (123,5 acres).

**Grape varieties:** 80% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Franc.

**Average age of the vines:** 28 years.

## Winemaking

**Harvesting:** By hand, into small crates to avoid bruising.  
Sorting before and after destemming.  
No crushing. The grapes are put into vats by gravity flow.

**Fermentation:** In temperature-controlled wooden and concrete vats for 25-30 days depending on the vintage.  
Extraction by pneumatic pigeage (punching down the cap).

**Malolactic fermentation and ageing:** In new oak barrels (up to 50%) on fine lees.  
Fining and filtering as necessary, depending on the vintage.

**Duration of barrel ageing:** 15-18 months.

The 2015 Chateau d'Aiguilhe is a blend of 85% Merlot and 15% Cabernet Franc, picked between September 23 and October 8 at 30 hectoliters per hectare, and matured in 30% new oak barrels. It has a very ripe and opulent, quite showing bouquet with fig and date-tinged red berry fruit. The palate is very well balanced, a supple ball of red cherry and strawberry fruit, with a touch of Christmas cake and allspice towards the finish; the Cabernet Franc imparts a little edginess, with a saline tincture lingering on the aftertaste. This is a very fine Côtes de Castillon from Comtes Von Neipperg. Drink: 2018 – 2028.

**Vinous – April 2016**

**88 – 91**

A huge wine, the 2015 d'Aiguilhe is endowed with serious intensity and richness. Waves of dark red fruit, plum, menthol and licorice flesh out in the glass. Hints of white pepper and chalk add an attractive upper register, but in 2015, Aiguilhe is mostly about texture and intensity, both of which it has in spades. Tasted three times. (Antonio Galloni).

**91 – 94 (Blind tasted)**

Features lush fruit, with creamy-edged plum, raspberry and blackberry flavors that glide along. There's depth here, but this is rounded and fresh in feel, with lovely purity. (James Molesworth).
