- ◆ **JAMES SUCKLING** : Cooked-apple, peach and pear aromas. Stone and chalk undertones. Full body. Dense and layered. Fantastic finish of dried citrus skin, salt and fruit. Beautiful now, but better in a year or two. Second wine of Domaine de Chevalier. **95**

- ◆ **JAMES MOLESWORTH** : Rich, yet youthfully compact, with notes of tarragon, verbena and honeysuckle infused deeply into a core of white peach, lemon peel and yellow apple fruit flavors. This should take on a creamier feel when it unwinds. Drink now through 2023. — **JM 92**

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- ◆ **JAMES SUCKLING** : A layered, pretty red with mineral, blackberry, terracotta and stone character. Medium-bodied with a lovely middle palate and good length. Beautiful, creamy texture. A little bitter at the end, but in a very attractive way. Drink after 2021. **94**
