


DOMAINE DE CHEVALIER

♦ JAMES SUCKLING :

The chocolate, walnut, dark-fruit and stone character is attractive. It's full-bodied and very tight and linear with chewy yet polished tannins and a long, flavorful finish. Lots of intensity and complexity here, as always. **96-97**

♦ IZAK LITWAR - GREAT BORDEAUX WINES

A sophisticated, deep and intense nose of blackberries and blueberries, a classy one. Full-bodied with style on the palate with excellent structure, complexity and length. Some graphite and scent of red meat on the palate coming from Cabernet Sauvignon, lush black fruit coming from Merlot and strong backbone is supported by Petit Verdot. All these grape varieties have a role to perform in here and the fruit cooperates perfectly with sweet and grained tannin. Great sophisticated touch and great length with a strong finish. Possibly the best ever vintage for red wine at Domaine de Chevalier? For me, it easily reaches heights of 2018 vintage or surpasses a bit compared when tasting from the barrel! **96-98p.**

♦ JEAN-MARC QUARIN

Couleur sombre, intense, pourpre, aux reflets noirs. Nez très aromatique, fin, pur, au fruité mûr et subtil. Minutieux dans sa texture dès l'entrée en bouche, très parfumé au milieu, savoureux, avec du corps et une nuance tendre, le vin s'achève très agréable, sur une longueur normale et sans angle. 2025 – 2042. **94/100 ; 17/20**
