HISTORY

Built in 1111, the tower of Château La Tour Carnet still dominates this great and exceptional vineyard today. Here the history of France is intertwined with that of the estate, which was to become the property of the Mon-taigne family, who gave France one of its most brilliant philosophers. Situated on an admirable terroir that pro-duces a great wine vintage after vintage, recognised for its elegance and its character, Château La Tour Carnet is undoubtedly part of the great history of the Classed Growths of the Haut-Médoc.

TASTING NOTES

This deep, powerful red wine opens with equally powerful fruit aromas, dominated by cherry and blackcurrant. These are enhanced by liquorice and spices, which pair beautifully with the supremacy of the fruit.

The palate opens with silken softness, gaining in depth but never losing the suppleness of those extremely fine and elegant tannins. An undercurrent of acidity is enough to provide the freshness and balance needed.

Depuis son édification au XIIème siècle, Château La Tour Carnet se confond avec l'Histoire de France. Demeure de la famille Montaigne au XVIème siècle, son vin devient célèbre en 1855 lors de son entrée au classement des Grands Crus. Les meilleures techniques sont utilisées pour exprimer toutes les qualités de son magnifique terroir viticole. Ce vin est aujourd'hui servi sur les plus grandes tables du monde.

Château La Tour Carnet has been the witness to the History of France since it was founded in the 12th century. The estate belonged to the Montaigne Familly in the 16th century, its wine becoming famous when it joined the 1855 Grands Crus classification. The best technics are used to express the great qualities of its magnificent vineyard. The wine is served today in the world's best restaurants.
