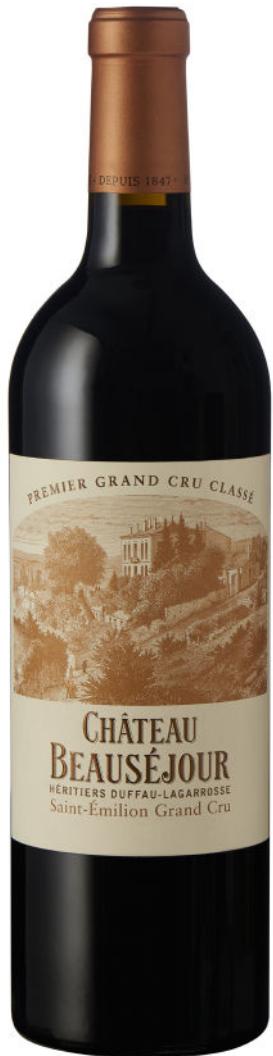


Château Beauséjour Duffau-Lagarrosse

1^{er} Grand-Cru Classé de Saint-Émilion



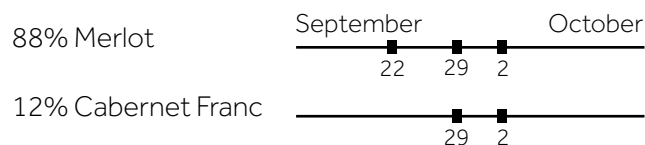
Vineyard / Vignoble

Enraciné sur le coteau, le vignoble de Beauséjour prend les airs d'un jardin posé sur la roche calcaire. Son terroir a magnifié admirablement le profil du millésime 2017. Année de contraste par excellence, entre les conditions froides du printemps et la sécheresse du tout début de l'été, la geste du vigneron ne visait, dans le respect des équilibres et de la fraîcheur du fruit, qu'à amener les baies à une parfaite maturité, sans ressentir les caprices du climat.

Firmly rooted on the hillsides, the Beauséjour vineyard looks like a garden resting on limestone outcrop. Its terroir admirably magnified the pedigree of the 2017 vintage. In a year of great contrasts, between cold spring conditions and the early summer drought, the vine-grower's husbandry was merely to bring the grapes to perfect ripeness – while respecting the balance and freshness of the fruit – without succumbing to the capricious nature of the climate.

Medium to full-bodied, it has a firm frame of ripe tannins and seamless freshness supporting the subdued, earthy layers, finishing long and minerally.
