93-95/100 - Wine Enthusiast, april 2014, by Roger Voss

Barrel Sample. Dark and intense, this is a richly endowed wine. It has swathes of blackberry fruits that are firmly upheld by solid tannins. The wine has a good potential.

90-92/100 - Vinous, april 2014, by Antonio Galloni

A highly distinctive, energetic wine, the 2013 Berliquet impresses for its length and focus. Dark red cherry, plum, smoke, spice and crushed rocks flow effortlessly from this beautiful, delineated St. Emilion. There is more than enough fruit to fill out the wine's frame nicely, but ultimately, the 2013 is a wine of precision and intense, saline-infused minerality. Today, my sense is that Berliquet is a rare 2013 that will need a few years in bottle. This is yet another fabulous showing from Nicolas Thienpont and his team. The 2013 is 74% Merlot and 26% Cabernet Franc harvested between September 30 and October 11. Tasted twice.

16,25/20 - Decanter, april 2014, by James Lawther MW

Fine, elegant style. Limestone terroir note. Acidity brings freshness. Firm finish.

89-90/100 - James Suckling, april 2014

Pretty finish with delicate plum and cherry character. Medium body, fine tannins and a fresh finish. The balance of fruit is very pretty at the finish.

88-91/100 - Wine Spectator, april 2014, by James Molesworth

Offers a rounded, flattering feel, with velvety plum and boysenberry notes kissed with subtle vanilla and ganache details. Manages to pull together a black fruit profile in this red fruit-marked vintage.
