Fronsac: Remarkable aromatic precision around notes of blackberry, spices and licorice. The Attack is full and frank, a dense and savoury mid-palate. Great success

Brigitte Rullier-Loussert took over the management of Chateau Dalem and de la Huste from her father in ( ). Both are located in Fronsac. She integrated an environmentally respectful demarche for both Chateau that is witnessed by her ISO 14001 certification. Located on the clay-limestone slopes (10 Hectares), Dalem is planted with 90% Merlot.

Brigitte Rullier-Loussert stresses the importance of the work in the vines in order to obtain quality grapes whose potential is revealed by classic-style vinifications and careful barrel ageing. Slightly rustic in former years, this cru has made notable progress as of late. The 2014 is brilliant, bursting with fruit and with polished tannins. One not to miss.

Brigitte Rullier-Loussert: She integrated an environmentally respectful demarche on her two domains, La Huste and Dalem.
