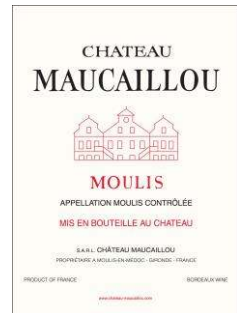


# CHATEAU MAUCAILLOU 2012



## PRIMEURS

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**WINE SPECTATOR** – Avril 2013

James MOLESWORTH

Note: **86-89**

Solid and slightly chunky, with a ganache frame holding the core of briar, blackberry paste and steeped plum notes together. A thick plum skin edge rides in on the finish. Shows more guts than charm, but remains solid nonetheless.



**SUCKLING.com** – Avril 2013

James Suckling

Note: **86-87**

Pleasant currant and berry character. Medium body, firm tannins but slightly hollow center palate.



**JANCIS ROBINSON.com** – Avril 2013

Jancis Robinson

Note : **15,5**

Fragrant, fresh fruit on the nose. A hint of liquorice. Again, the fruit seems submerged in drying oak. Very painful on the palate at the moment. Not enough fruit concentration in the middle.



**WINE ENTHUSIAST** – Avril 2013

Note : **90-92**

This is a solid and dense wine with hints of bitter chocolate along with super-ripe blackberry fruits. The wine has concentration, richness and a fine ageing potential. - R.V.



**DECANTER** – Avril 2013

Dense colour, big, succulent quite earthy fruit, quite raw tannins, needs time. 2016 - 2024



**CONNECTIONS TO WINE** – Avril 2013

Note : **16**

Somewhat darker hue than Chasse Spleen wine. Initial nose of plum, vanilla. Aeration brings garden aromas. Supple attack, soft overall, tannins are polite here, but is it playing things a bit too safe? The somewhat modest finish certainly results in a build of intensity, but the mid palate seems to lack enough body.



**NEW BORDEAUX** – Avril 2013

Note : **15,5**

Butterscotch and caramel, fairly gourmet nose, unfortunately on the attack you get pinched fruit, touch of pyrazine. Nothing too awry, there is some fruit evident, more cassis (high acidity scale) than blackberry, some bitter chocolate giving a flourish to the finish - a little disconnect between the nose and palate. Potential, but there is a long way to go for this to join the dots, so once again stick to early to medium term drinking to avoid disappointment. 85/15.5. **Recommended**. Drink 2018-2026.

Quite elegant fruit, red and dark berries, spices, rounded and rather dense texture, good length, juicy and balanced.

Dark purple red with violet hue and almost black center. Clean nose with hints of dark berries, mulberries and elderberries. Toasted flavours in the background. On the palate well structured with medium weight and length.
