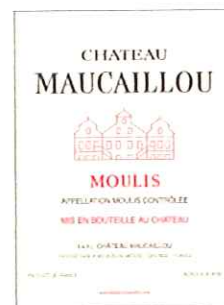


## CHATEAU MAUCAILLOU 2016



## PRIMEURS

The 2016 Maucaillou has a well-defined, tertiary, sous-bois scented bouquet that Unfolds in the glass but resolutely remains "classic" in style, revealing pleasant tobacco scents with time. The palate is medium-bodied with a bit of new oak showing its hand on the entry. That will need to be assimilated during elevage. But there is commendable depth towards the finish that has a subtle spiciness on the aftertaste. Tasted twice, the second time attested to improvement in bottle and I think it will continue that trajectory during its barrel maturation.

Here we are stepping up a gear. Tender ripe berry fruits and a swirl of spice from the oak without being overly sweet. The tannins have a pliable sense to them, you can feel the juice squeezing right on through. Planted to 51% Cabernet Sauvignon, 42% Merlot and 7% Petit Verdot.
