

## PRIMEURS

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**WINE ADVOCATE** - Avril 2018 - USA

The 2017 Maucaillou is medium to deep garnet-purple in color and scented of cedar chest and yeast extract over cassis and blackberry pie at the core. The palate is medium-bodied with good mid-palate intensity and plenty of black fruit, supported by fine-grained tannins and great freshness.

A juicy and medium fruity red with plums and hints of walnut undertones. Firm tannins and a fresh finish. Nice touch of ripeness to this.

The oak is a touch dominant, although its cedar caress to the fruit is enjoyable, as are the soft chocolate notes. This is certainly carefully extracted, presenting a seductive contemporary feel. This estate has handled the frost impact cleverly, producing a wine that is good for early to medium drinking.

## WINE CHRONICLES - Mai 2018 - USA

The clean nose is appreciable as is the mid palate suppleness. There is a bit of oak tannin perhaps that dries out, at least the oak derivation seems just a bit too prominent on the finish. Otherwise, fine. The estate blend 52% Cabernet Sauvignon, 41% Merlot and 7% petit Verdot, and it, too, was also affected by the Frost.
