- Since its creation in 1994, Pagodes de Cos is made from grapes grown on a **dedicated terroir** whose **vines are 35 years old** on average.
- The **ongoing presence and experience of our winegrowers** were critical through the growth cycle of this vintage, notably illustrated by the decision to plough more intensely and frequently than usual.
- Drawing on **our experience harnessing our gravity-flow cellar** for the past ten years, we were able to treat this harvest with the utmost care and precision.
- **An introduction to the style of Cos d'Estournel** : a lovely balance against an exceptional freshness.
- A discreetly seductive wine, with **magnificent aromas of berries and wonderful fullness**.
