2018 Bordeaux Barrels Tasting : Top-Scoring Reds

Château Pichon Lalande is among 2018's potential superstars.

This one nails it in 2018, with saturated, almost sappy kirsch, plum and blackberry preserve flavors at the core, inlaid with sweet tobacco, singed vanilla, worn cedar and fresh earth notes. A bolt of graphite provides support. Concentrated, long and very complete. One of the high water marks of the vintage.

I tasted it several times, and it always has a juiciness and elegance different to many Pauillacs in 2018. Layers of softness and concentration of raspberries, peonies, and woodsmoke, with slow-building slate, cedar, liquorice and a tannic grip that is a signature of Pauillac. It has the elegance and power of 2016 and is one of the most seductive Comtesse ever. Can't wait to taste it in bottle ! Drink 2026 - 2040

Pourpre violacé. Le nez de Pichon Comtesse laisse rapidement entrevoir qu'il veut convaincre, séduire et surprendre. Que de précision et de finesse. Notes de mûres, d'épices, de bois de réglisse et de menthe. Maturité et fraîcheur forment décidément un beau couple ! Mise en bouche subtile, précise, crémeuse et même un peu juteuse. Le vin s'installe doucement, lentement et gagne en ampleur au fil des secondes. THE WINE CELLAR INSIDER

Full-bodied, rich, powerful, dense, opulent and frankly, incredibly sexy, as well as structured, stylistically it feels like a blend of 2009 and 2016 with the best attributes of each vintage. This wine is sensual with firm tannins, vitality, length, complexity and vibrancy in the finish. Yes, the wine is high in alcohol. But there is no heat, jam or lack of freshness. Everything here is in balance. Lay this down for a decade and pour sensuality right into your glass. The wine will age effortlessly for decades. Is it better than the perfect 100 Pt. 2016? Maybe, maybe not. But I cannot wait to taste those two vintages side by side in a blind tasting. The wine combines 71% Cabernet Sauvignon, 23% Merlot, 7% Cabernet Franc and 1% Petit Verdot reaching 14% alcohol with a pH of 3.85. The picking took place September 13-October 11 and 50% of the crop was placed into the Grand Vin. The yields were low here this year at only 35 hectoliters per hectare.

Full-bodied, tight and integrated with a refreshing and harmonious finish. Just floating on the palate. Great tannin backbone to this. A classic. Another flying carpet.

Bordeaux : 2018 En Primeur

The grand vin represents 50% of the crop this year. The 2018 Pichon Longueville Comtesse de Lalande is made up of 71% Cabernet Sauvignon, 23% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc and 1% Petit Verdot with a pH of 3.85, an IPT (total polyphenol index) of 87 and 14% alcohol. Very deep purple-black colored, it is like hitting a brick wall to begin, needing considerable coaxing to start to reveal notes of crushed black cherries, warm blackberries, ripe blackcurrants and chocolate cake with nuances of violets, rose hip tea, charcuterie, tapenade and incense with wafts of new leather and iron ore. Full-bodied, concentrated and completely laden with tightly wound black fruit and savory layers, the palate gives a rock-solid backbone of firm, super ripe, super fine-grained tannins and soft background freshness, finishing very long with a veritable display of mineral fireworks.

The 2018 Pichon-Longueville Comtesse de Lalande is powerful, dense and explosive, with a real sense of vertical lift that conveys energy. Grilled herbs, lavender, inky blue/purplish fruit and spice notes develop in the glass, but it is the wine's balance, purity of tannin and finish that stand out most. In 2018, so many wines lean towards extreme versions of themselves, but Pichon-Longueville Comtesse de Lalande remains very much within its classic parameters. The 2018 doesn't quite offer the visceral thrill of the very best recent vintages, but it comes very close. At its purest essence, the 2018 is very Pichon-Longueville Comtesse de Lalande. The en primeur sample is shown from 100% new oak, although the wine will have about 60% new wood. Tasted four times.

Bordeaux 2018 : Pauillac

The blend is 71% Cabernet Sauvignon, 23% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc and 1% Petit Verdot. This has a dark and smoky character on the nose, rather reticent and cool on my first tasting with the UGC, but when tasted later in the week at the château it was more expressive, open and charming, with finely poised lack cherry, blackcurrant and damson fruits. The palate is fresh, broad and bold, with a rather elegant texture, open and carrying a ripe bed of nicely knit tannins and a fresh, bright acidity. Rich yet elegant, polished, with substantial fruit, showing a beautifully sinewy style and a long, grippy finish, this feels relaxed but this is deceptive, as there is a brooding bed of black fruits here, with a rich bed of tannin wrapped up within it. The style is long, energetic, fresh and cool, with a flourish of rich tannic substance in the finish, the second sample much more convincing than first. A really imposing style, with very fine potential, dark, quite lovely, but no over-ripe. Delicious. The élevage here is 60% new and 40% second-fill oak.

For hedonists and intellectuals : Bordeaux 2018

Super Second, anyone? Here we have a tour de force that rivals both Latour and Margaux. Such a smooth Pichon Comtesse, once again proving the cliché that it comes across just as much Saint Julien as Pauillac. It stands out before all other Pauillac wines assessed last week at the UGCB tasting. At once supple and elegant, yet layered and long. What a great performance! Tasted twice again, at the négociant Joanne on 31 March and at the château three days later: sheer elegance, with iodine freshness. Alcohol is 14% precisely with just enough balancing acidity and plenty of tannin. "Many things made me think of 2010," says director Nicolas Glumineau, as we have not seen such quality of must since the 2010 (when he was at Montrose). Powerful but fresh. Here a case where the 2018 enters legend and may well surpasses the 2016.

Ein zartes Parfüm nach Wildkirschen und Veilchen sowie Nougat-Pralinen. Im zweiten Ansatz Lakritze, Cassis und Heidelbeeren. Am kräftigen Gaumen mit cremiger Textur, perfekt ausgereiften Tanninen un süßem Extrakt, unaubliche Eleganz aufweisend, dann packtdieses Finessenpaket zu.
