

The second wine of Château Pichon-Longueville Comtesse, the 2020 Reserve De Comtesse De Lalande is a beautiful wine in the making that certainly tastes like a mini-version of the Grand Vin. Lots of crème de cassis, blueberries, violets, tobacco, and earth all define the nose, and it hits the palate with a forward, medium to full-bodied, supple texture that already begs to be drunk. I love its balance, the purity of fruit is terrific, and the tannins are spot on as well. It ranks as one of the top second wines in the vintage and will have two decades of prime drinking.

Composed of 47% Merlot, 43% Cabernet Sauvignon and 10% Petit Verdot, the 2020 Reserve de la Comtesse is redolent of cassis, redcurrant jelly and raspberry coulis, plus suggestions of chocolate box, lilacs and stewed tea, with a waft of unsmoked cigars. The medium-bodied palate delivers mouth-coating, juicy black fruits with a soft texture and seamless freshness, finishing long with a spicy kick. This is a very different style from the grand vin, possessing a more playful, upfront and effortlessly delicious character that truly draws you in!

The 2020 Réserve de la Comtesse is absolutely gorgeous. Far more expressive than the Grand Vin today, the Réserve is everything a second wine should be. Ripe dark cherry, plum, spice, menthol, licorice and tobacco all flesh out in a sumptuous, racy Pauillac that impresses with its alluring personality. This is an especially fine vintage for the Réserve. The 2020 is 47% Merlot, 43% Cabernet Sauvignon and 10% Petit Verdot – in other words, a high percentage of PV that undoubtedly marks the blend. 2026-240.

Closed to smell, but tight and very mineral; rich, vital, finely tannic, a very fine second-wine constitution, in a slightly more austere register for RC; tasting sweet and juicy, very Cabernet Sauvignon despite the dominance of Merlot, but the flesh of the Merlot also clear; both flesh and complexity here, very long and close-grained to taste, dark and vital, and with lovely fragrant persistence. Some way from the aromatic volume of Pichon itself, but so elegant, so complete. A superb-quality second wine, with almost a “grand vin” character. So supple that it is likely to be drinkable fairly early, but will keep for decades.

The 2020 Réserve de Pichon Comtesse is very harmonious on the nose, featuring plenty of blackberry, wild strawberry and light touches of salted licorice and estuarine scents; this is going to be very seductive. The palate is medium-bodied with sappy black fruit and fine-grained tannins, not a powerful or deep Deuxième Vin, leading to a poised, quite spicy, peppery finish. This should give 12–15 years of drinking pleasure. 2026-2038

This is a blend of 43% Cabernet Sauvignon, 47% Merlot and 10% Petit Verdot, picked at an overall yield of 30 hl/ha. As you might expect in this vintage, this second wine, made by Nicolas Glumineau, has a dense, almost opaque appearance, with a modest red cherry rim. The definition to the fruit on the nose is really quite precise, beginning with finely expressed blackcurrant fruits, before then moving into damson, juniper berry and the barest touch of green peppercorn. It begins in a rather modest fashion on the palate, with a medium-bodied presence and a rather peppery energy. There is a little grain to the substance of the wine, and a rather firm and pointed body of tannins set within it. With a slightly dry structure, and a little concentration evident on the finish and length, this is clearly a second wine built for the cellar. A job well done here.

Bright ruby colour with violet reflections. As with many second wines in Pauillac in 2020, you should expect fairly high tannins, although they are fine in construction and softly-expressed when things open up. Cocoa bean and coffee smoke on the finish. This is seductive but underplayed. Drinking Window 2024 – 2038.

Wow. This could so easily be the **grand vin itself**, until you have a glass of each in your hand. The most sumptuous nose in which I am struck actually by how much of a role the oak plays. We think of Bordeaux as trying, in a way, to wean itself (and, in the process, us) off new oak – but it is vital part of the flush and sumptuous character of this more gloriously Pauillac of Pauillac second labels. The fruit is gorgeously ripe and opulent – cassis and black cherries, fruits of the forest, a hint of wild blueberry and super-ripe brambles – and the presence of the jet black graphite completes the fantastically well-integrated totality of this.

Having not yet gotten to the grand vin whilst I type this I am still asking myself what more I could find there! On the palate this is amazingly plush and deep and completely mouth-filling and I am pinching myself once again – is this really not the grand vin? I guess the tannins are not quite as fine-grained as I could just about imagine that they might be in the first wine and the oak is quite evident and has not yet been fully absorbed, leaving this a little dusted in vanilla and slightly sweet-tinged. But this is a profound wine of incredible depth and concentration that will surely age gracefully for at least a couple of decades. Incredible.

Le nez est fruité, frais, élégant, finement serré et offre une certaine richesse en finesse. On y retrouve des notes de cassis sauvage mûre, de petits fruits noirs mûrs et plus légèrement de graphite associées à des touches de camphre, d'épices ainsi qu'à de fines pointes de thé noir, de graves racées, à une subtile pointe de noix de muscade, de poivre gris, de bleuet et de glaïeul. La bouche est fruitée, racée et offre de la jutosité, de la fraîcheur, une bonne définition, de la gourmandise, une trame acidulée, de la délicatesse, de la puissance, de la complexité, un côté aérien, un joli grain ainsi qu'une certaine délicatesse dans sa puissance. En bouche ce vin exprime des notes de petites baies noires sauvages, de cassis pulpeux et plus légèrement de prune noire pulpeuse/juteuse associées à des touches de cerise éclatante, de framboise ainsi qu'à des pointes de camphre, de thé noir, à de fines pointes de minéralité racée / presque saline et à de fines pointes de cacao. Les tannins sont précis, bien menés et très finement moelleux. Bonne longueur. Présence d'une subtile pointe de caramélisation ainsi que d'une fine pointe saline sur la fin de bouche/persistance. Jolie persistance et gourmandise.

Grand Vin parent, but when you consider the prodigious finish, which rolls on for minutes, it is imperative to have a second and then a third look because there is more to discover here than I expected. Unmistakably PL-shaped, this is a rather grand second wine with an almost identical silhouette of its parent. The nose is superb and the palate is medium-weight, refined and savoury. This is a great effort and it suits the recently renovated label and name! Bearing in mind just how backward the Grand Vin seems, I would be tempted to shop here in 2020 and save some cash!
