TERROIR

The vineyards of Château Né Nin are all in one piece, with the exception of one plot. The vines dedicated to the grand vin of Château Né Nin are planted on the largest clay and gravel terroirs of the Pomerol plateau, covering about one third of the total vineyard. In the context of the Pomerol appellation, where it is rare for an estate to exceed 10 hectares, Château Né Nin represents a major surface: up to 32 hectares of vines in production. Consequently, its terroir includes all the diversity of soils that characterise Pomerol. It is mainly made up of Oligocene deposits covered with gravelly alluvial formations of the Dordogne; siliceous clays and gravels, quartz, granites, iron dross as well as basalt pebbles.

VINTAGE 2020

The year 2020 began with a lot of difficulties, with a wet and mild winter's exit, followed by a capricious spring that could not tolerate approximation. Although rain and temperatures initiated a historic precociousness, water reserves were sufficient to get through the long summer season without the vines suffering, and the grapes ripened in splendid weather. Warm days and cool nights alternated until the grapes were carefully harvested to ensure homogeneous ripeness, with no compromise. The Grand Vin of the Château Né Nin 2020 conveys great balance, illuminated by splendid freshness. The tannic tension is a promise of great elegance, coated by our rich Merlot and our structured Cabernet Francs.
