This fine white wine, chosen by connoisseurs of great wines, is naturally present on the finest tables in the world.

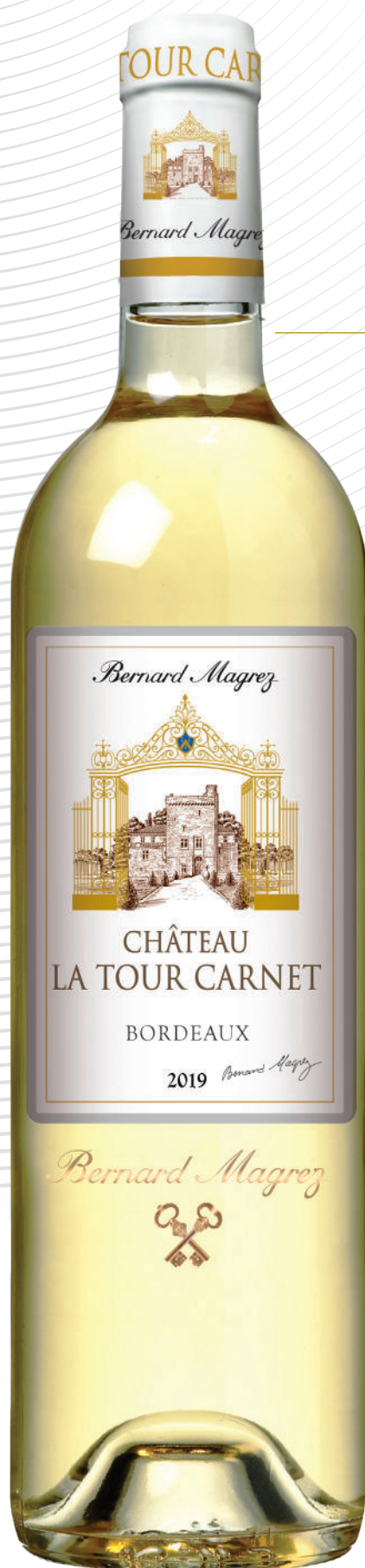

## NOTES DE DEGUSTATION

It opens richly, almost excessively so on the palate but is reined in by a rising acidity, the perfect partner to the exquisitely complex aromas.





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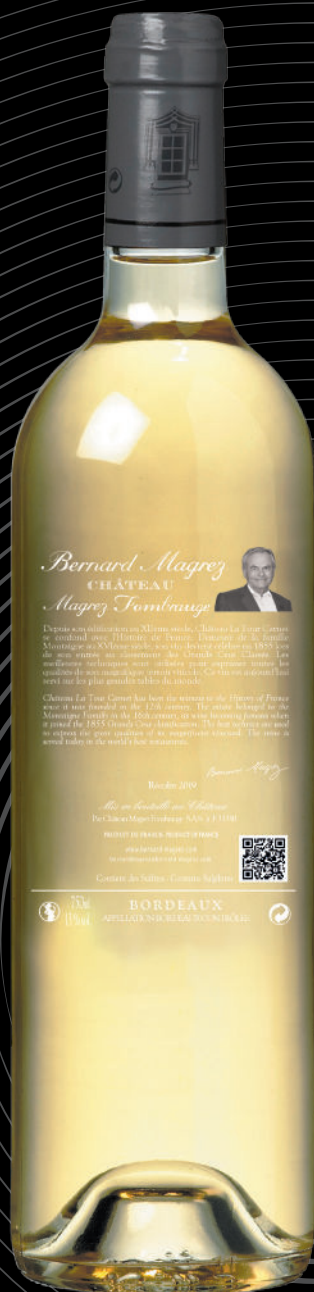

Depuis son édification au XII<sup>ème</sup> siècle, Château La Tour Carnet se confond avec l'Histoire de France. Demeure de la famille Montaigne au XVI<sup>ème</sup> siècle, son vin devient célèbre en 1855 lors de son entrée au classement des Grands Crus Classés. Les meilleures techniques sont utilisées pour exprimer toutes les qualités de son magnifique terroir viticole. Ce vin est aujourd'hui servi sur les plus grandes tables du monde.

Château La Tour Carnet has been the witness to the History of France since it was founded in the 12<sup>th</sup> century. The estate belonged to the Montaigne family in the 16<sup>th</sup> century, its wine becoming famous when it joined the 1855 Grands Crus classification. The best techniques are used to express the great qualities of its magnificent vineyard. The wine is served today in the world's best restaurants.
