Certainly the year 2013 was complicated. But the **selection work**, the quality of our terroir and the **precise knowledge** of literally each vine allowed us to counter the vagaries of nature and to pick grapes of **perfect quality**.

The rigour of the selection has revealed a vintage with unique balance, very precise, very pure with a wide-ranging of aromatic complexity, both fruity and spicy. On the palate, the tannins are silky and intense, with a particularly **long and brilliant finish.**'
