VINEYARD MANAGEMENT

Pruning: double guyot, debudding

Leaf removal: by hand rising side and sunset

side if necessary

Green harvesting: if necessary

WINEMAKING / AGEING

Winemaking: by plots in small concrete vats with internal temperature control and integral

vinification in oak barrel

Ageing: 70% in new barrels, 30% in one year old barrels

Ageing period: 14 to 18 months depending

on plots

75% Merlot, 22% Cabernet Franc, 3% Cabernet Sauvignon

First harvest date:
