The vineyards are located between Margaux and St Julien, and they were frosted, although Frédéric and Hélène opted not to try to use any second-generation fruit. This has a lovely blackcurrant freshness with a curranty concentration, with little touches of black cherry, in a very fresh, very bright, surprisingly fragrant and aromatic style. The palate is fresh, supple, cool, with lovely fruit substance and a fresh central seam of tannins. It is rich, sinewy, poised, bright. Long moderately grained tannins, For a frosted vineyard, a little west of the *Gironde*, this perfumed, grippy and ultimately ripe wine represents a great deal of work and commitment. A very fine Retout here.
