Located at the entry door of Haut Médoc, the story of Ch. Clément Pichon began in the 14th century and became of the most famous building of the area. Clément Fayat (Ch. La Dominique in Saint Emilion, Ch. Fayat in Pomerol), who bought the estate in 1976, has now decided that the property has to be recognized, not only as a jewel of architecture but as one of the cutting edge property of the Left Bank. Thus 25 hectares has been replanted since his arrival and all the best practices have been implemented, under the direction of Yannick Evenou, advised by Michel Rolland. It is now the leading Cru Bourgeois in its category
