

LA CHAPELLE DE LA MISSION HAUT-BRION

A sacred and rare charm

Produced in small batches, this second wine is a gateway to the Château La Mission Haut-Brion universe. Even while young, it seduces the senses.

Its name nods to the La Mission Haut-Brion chapel built by Lazarist priests in 1698, and also pays homage to the priests at La Mission who dedicated themselves to improving winegrowing and wine quality throughout the 18th century. La Chapelle de La Mission Haut-Brion has a beautiful, deep red color and a first nose of fresh and ripe fruit.

When swirled in a glass, a pleasing woody vanilla note enhances its cherry and blackberry aromas. From the outset, the wine works its charms with fleshy and fruity Merlots, as the structure emerges and its tannic powers come through with full-bodied freshness. Medium-length, with a spicy finish.

This vintage is reminiscent of 2008, marrying a beautiful tannic structure with a very nice freshness.



CHÂTEAU LA MISSION HAUT-BRION

The soul of a Premier Grand Cru

The wine is a beautiful deep purple-red.

The nose is intense, with hints of raspberry and blackberry. What is striking as it swirls in the glass is its ripe fruitiness. The vanilla and delicately spicy, woody notes marry perfectly without dominating. The first expression is round, full and ample, leading into a dense and flavorful mid-palate. Black fruit and licorice notes dominate the taste, followed by a juicy and velvety tannic structure.

Since the start of the barrel aging process, this incredibly charming wine has gone from strength to strength and immediately reminds us of the outstanding 2000 vintage, but with more density. A 2000+!
