Haut-Bailly est étonnamment charmeur et délicat et se pare, dans ce millésime, d'un charme fou. Des notes de violette, de mure, de myrtille, de fruits frais noirs et une touche de réglisse/fusain. Sapide et velouté en bouche, très beaux tanins, une bouche sur l'allonge avec un grain d'une très grande précision. Finale légèrement structurante, ce qui sera gommé pendant les élevages, pour un vin d'une très grande race.

The 2021 Haut-Bailly is built around 65% Cabernet Sauvignon, the blend employing less Merlot and more Petit Verdot this year since the latter was not affected by frost. It was picked between September 27 and October 11 and matured in 50% new oak with 10% vin de presse. Allowed to open in the glass, it unfurls to reveal blackberry, briar, touches of crushed stone and cedar. The taut, fresh palate is medium-bodied with sappy black fruit and fine acidity. This is back to the older style of Haut-Bailly in some ways; less opulent, **in keeping with the style of the vintage**, and delivering good weight on the finish, even if there is not the persistent aftertaste of previous vintages. The great virtue of this Haut-Bailly is the **sapidity** that marks the conclusion. The kind of Pessac-Léognan that needs to be decanted then poured at the dinner table.

A classic in the making, the 2021 Haut-Bailly wafts from the glass with aromas of dark berries and wild plums mingled with sweet spices, loamy soil, raw cocoa and violets. Medium to full-bodied, seamless and concentrated, with bright acids, ultra-refined tannins and a long, penetrating finish, it's a blend of 65% Cabernet Sauvignon, only 22% Merlot, 10% Petit Verdot and 3% Cabernet Franc. With yields of a mere 19 hectoliters per hectare, it's impressively intensely flavored despite its **quintessentially elegant**, classically proportioned profile. In many respects, it may represent the Cabernet-driven modern-day alter ego of the superb Merlot-dominant 1998 Haut-Bailly.

The 2021 Haut-Bailly is a dark, rather somber wine. The aromatics alone are **captivating**, but there are strong savory inflections from the high percentage of Petit Verdot in this year's blend. This deceptively mid-weight Haut-Bailly has plenty to offer. Spice, leather, tobacco and incense linger. The final blend also includes 10% press wine.

Impresses from the first moment with its enveloping nose, and purity of flavour. **Plenty of estate signature**, with finely grained tannins and creamy black fruit that is concentrated with density through the mid palate but not opulent, delivering cocoa bean, slate, cassis and gunsmoke personality and poise. One of the few where I can really see the comparison to 1996, or perhaps 2000, with firm tannins that are subdued but with clear ageing potential. **An excellent Haut-Bailly**, with a small 19hl/h yield, meaning that in this first year with the new cellar they used just 20 of the smallest size vats (out of 50 in total). Harvest September 27 to October 11. Axel Marhal consultant.

Dark purple colour with violet hue and black core. Excellent aromatic expression, blackcurrants and blackberries, black cherries in the background, floral hints, violets and wisteria, a wine with precision and freshness. On the palate firm yet ripe and balanced tannins, refined fruit and floral hints, discreet spiciness and subtle oak, **exciting tension** on the palate with **excellent length**.

The 2021 Château Haut-Bailly checks in as 65% Cabernet Sauvignon, 22% Merlot, 10% Petit Verdot, and the rest Cabernet Franc. It's another **elegant, pure, incredibly balanced** wine from this château, offering complex aromatics (cassis, smoked tobacco, spicy wood, and earth), medium body, ripe, supple tannins, and a great finish. Hitting 13% alcohol with a pH of 3.9, this **seamless beauty** will drink nicely right out of the gate yet evolve for 25-30 years.

The 2021 Haut-Bailly is a blend of 65% Cabernet Sauvignon, 22% Merlot, 10% Petit Verdot, and 3% Cabernet Franc, harvested from 27 September to 11 October, and aging in 50% new oak. Deep garnet-purple colored, it is a little closed and broody to begin, opening out to offer notes of plum preserves, warm cassis, and black raspberries, plus suggestions of fertile loam, tapenade, tar, and smoked meats. Medium-bodied, the palate has **wonderful tension and energy** with plenty of black fruit layers and a **fine-grained texture**, culminating in a long, lifted finish. This was the first vintage in the new winery, and 50% of the crop went into the grand vin.

Initially you notice the blackberries, black plums, and black currants before moving on to the tobacco, flowers, spice, and smoke in the aromatic profile. Supple, refined, and elegant, perhaps the best way to describe the wine is **modern chic**, or **modern classic** if you prefer. The tannins are **soft and polished**, and the fruit is **pure, clean, and fresh**, with a salty, mildly-chalky, **supple** endnote. Although it is going to probably always be a bit reticent in character, you will be able to approach and enjoy this wine in its youth, as well as age it for more complexity. The wine blends 65% Cabernet Sauvignon, 22% Merlot, 10% Petit Verdot and 3% Cabernet Franc. The blend represents the highest percentage of Petit Verdot in the history of the estate. 13% ABV, pH 3.9. The harvest took place September 27 to October 11. The Grand Vin was produced from 50% of the harvest. is the first vintage produced in their new, state-of-the-art cellars. Drink from 2025-2055.

There is an extra boost of Cabernet Sauvignon in 2021 Haut-Bailly and Petit Verdot handled the various climatic challenges extremely well, and so these two grapes form the tremendous base of this wine. Sensual Merlot dresses the core of fruit, and Cabernet Franc adds an irresistible fragrance to this beautiful being. This is a **thrilling Haut-Bailly**, and it possesses one of the longest and most evenly balanced flavours I have tasted from this property. The acid and tannin refinement is on another level, and these components extend the finish, drawing it out to profound proportions. At every step of the way, **the levels of refinement set new quality and sophistication bars for this Château**. While it is clear that the viti and vini teams have instinctively pulled a rabbit out of the hat this year, the new winery, with its extraordinary design and enviable technological capabilities, has enabled Véronique Sanders and her colleagues to perform at the highest level. **2021 Haut-Bailly captures more of the essence of this property than ever before**. This is all one can ask from a bottle of wine, and achieving this in 2021 is nothing short of a miracle.

The best Graves red from barrel among those tasted (I missed the Clarence Dillon properties and Les Carmes Haut Brion). Tannic finesse, rather sumptuous ripeness and impressive acidity/tannin balance (so important in this vintage) make the cut. The success in this blend of 65% Cabernet Sauvignon, 22% Merlot, 10% Petit Verdot and 3% Cabernet Franc is **testimony to the talented team and to the new cellars inaugurated for this vintage**. Warmer, gravel soils in the cooler summer worked well, as pickers waited to 12 October for as much ripeness as possible. Alcohol is 13% and aging in 50% new oak. Let's see how it tastes from bottle!

The grand vin is 65% Cabernet Sauvignon, 22% Merlot, 10% Petit Verdot and 3% Cabernet Franc, all picked between September 27th and October 11th. It takes 50% of the crop. It was of course vinified in the estate's beautiful new cellars. The aromatic profile moves on from the delicate red fruits of the second wine to show more concentration, with darker red fruits smoked with traces of leather and toasted tobacco. The palate is supple, nicely polished, with a medium-bodied elegance, a lightly silky and sinewy substance, very precisely delineated, with a supple blanket of red cherry and perfumed red fruits. This feels quite **classically poised, with more tension and elegance than many of its peers** display in this vintage. Long, lightly toasted, and charming. The alcohol is 12.96%. 92-94/100
