Château Clément-Pichon Haut-Médoc Cru Bourgeois

- Owner : Fayat family
- Wine consultant : Michel Rolland
- Vineyard Area : 25 ha
- Harvested from 2nd to 10th October
- Yield : 25 hl/ha
- Average age of vineyard : 30 years
- Density : 7 500 vines/ha
- Grape types : 62% Merlot, 33% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc
- Soil types : large gravel on the surface
- Cellar : thermo-regulated stainless steel tanks, traditional vinification
- Ageing : 12 months in French oak barrels, renewed by third each year
