Château Clément-Pichon Haut-Médoc Cru Bourgeois

• Owner: Fayat family

• Wine consultant : Michel Rolland

• Vineyard Area: 25 ha

• Harvested from 2nd to 10th October

• Yield: 25 hl/ha

• Average age of vineyard: 30 years

• Density: 7 500 vines/ha

• Grape types: 62% Merlot, 33% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc

• Soil types : large gravel on the surface

Cellar: thermo-regulated stainless steel tanks, traditional vinification
Ageing: 12 months in French oak barrels, renewed by third each year
