



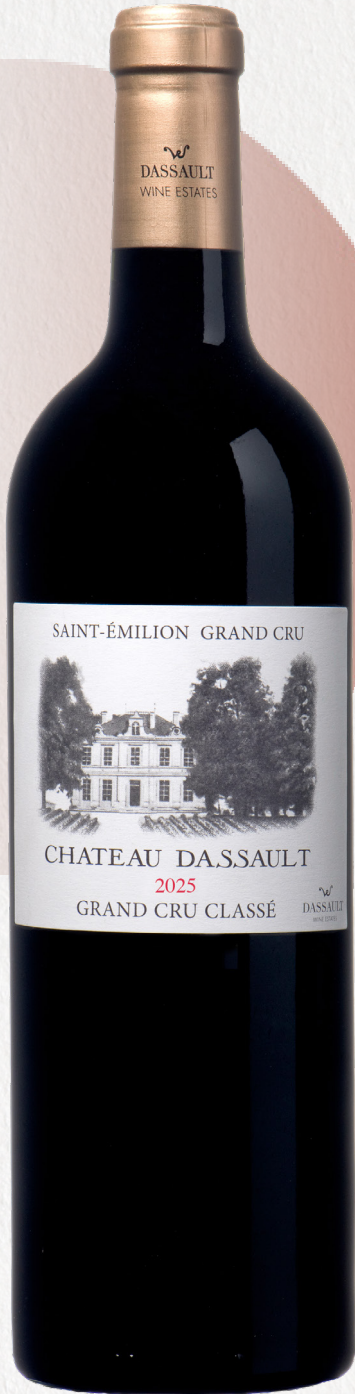

2025 Vintage - Depth & Balance

The 2025 vintage confirms the qualitative evolution of Château Dassault's wines and marks a significant step forward into this new era.

Characterized by exceptional earliness, the harvest showed exciting qualitative potential from the very start of the season, allowing the vintage to be approached with serenity.

Remarkable for its balance and freshness, Château Dassault 2025 is generous and silky, featuring suave and well-integrated tannins. The mouth-watering finish prolongs the expression of the fruit. A great vintage perfectly in tune with the times.



Climatology

A dry and mild winter - Slightly milder (+0.3°C) and drier (-12% precipitation), budburst began in early April under clement weather conditions.

A hot and dry spring - Following a rainy period in April, hot and dry conditions allowed for flowering in mid-May. Early and rapid, it set the stage for homogenous ripening.

A particularly sunny summer with low rainfall - Veraison, much like flowering, took place quickly and evenly starting July 24th. Ripening continued ideally through the intense August heat. Showers at the end of the month allowed for an increase in berry size and a reduction in sugar concentration.

Harvest & Vinification

Harvesting began on September 9th for the Merlot, followed by Cabernet Franc on September 22nd and Cabernet Sauvignon on September 26th. These were the earliest harvests ever recorded at the estate.

During vinification, as polyphenols were naturally very abundant, gentle extraction was prioritized to fully harness the potential of the grapes.

Tasting Notes

Boasting an intense and deep robe with ruby-purple highlights, the nose opens with a very pure aromatic profile of ripe red fruits. Generous and silky, the palate is balanced and deep with beautiful energy.

Technical Information

Alcohol Content : 13.5% vol

PH : 3.66

Vineyard Location

Surface area : 39 hectares (30 in production), located on the northern slope of the Saint-Émilion hill.

Soils : Clay-limestone slopes, clay over limestone substrate, sandy-clay, and clay-sandy soils.

Grape Varieties : 66% Merlot, 26% Cabernet Franc, 8% Cabernet Sauvignon.

Average vine age : 21 years.

Viticulture, Vinification & Aging

Viticulture : Sustainable farming (culture raisonnée), shallow soil tillage, and cover cropping. Simple or double Guyot pruning. Bud thinning.

Vinification : Densimetric sorting upon reception of the harvest, gravity-fed vatting, plot-by-plot vinification in thermo-regulated stainless steel tanks.

Ageing : 56% new barrels, 16% second-fill barrels, 13% large oak casks (foudres), 11% concrete tanks, 4% amphorae.

Blend : 78% Merlot, 17% Cabernet Franc, 5% Cabernet Sauvignon.

Annual Production : 80,000 bottles.

The Château Dassault vineyard is certified High Environmental Value 3 (HVE3), ISO 14001, and holds the Bee Friendly label.
