Terroir

Approximately **40 hectares dedicated to the Grand Vin**, two clay-gravel hilltops on a limestone base, sometimes outcropping
 A vineyard with an average age of 45 years, and 100-year-old Cabernet Franc vines
 Highest point at 35 m above sea level
 Chalky soils guarantee an **expression of minerality, tension and freshness**
 Conservatory of vines - massal selections from Léoville Las Cases -

Identity

Historic cradle of the Delon family
 Wine production **recognised for centuries** (already included in the first edition of the Féret book in 1850)
 Wine renowned for its high quality, **consistency** and **ageing capacity**
 Continuous search for **balance, purity** and **pleasure**
 The 19th century **Chapel** lends its name and image to the second wine
 Improved label for more finesse from the 2018 vintage
