

FRANK PHELAN 2012

Harvest:

➤ Merlot: 8 to 14 October.

Cabernet Sauvignon : 13 to 19 October

Tasting notes dated 15 January 2015

Red fruit bouquet with good maturity (cherries, strawberries).

Delicate texture; sweet, voluptuous, well-rounded attack. Silky tannins provide excellent density on the mid-palate. Very nice smooth finish with lingering flavours; the 2012 Frank PHELAN makes enjoyable drinking when it is still very young.

GRAPE VARIETIES:

Cabernet Sauvignon : 60% Merlot : 40%

WEATHER CONDITIONS DURING THE YEAR:

> Rainfall:

February and March were relatively dry. Rainfall in April was twice the average. July and September 2012 were very dry; weather conditions deteriorated from late September.

> From flowering to harvest

Flowering: Uneven. Following a late bud break, flowering was spread over June

Start of ripening: Spread over August

Flower abortion: Low and variable depending on plot and varietal

Leaf removal: Removal of leaves and thinning of bunches adapted to the water stress for

each plot.

> The harvests

The dramatic change in the weather at the end of September meant that great care was required

Our capacity to harvest quickly (12 days) enabled us to work calmly and stay in control
