



## Vineyard

Ten years after the arrival of Nicolas Thienpont, assisted by David Suire, Château Larcis Ducasse was promoted to Saint-Emilion Premier Grand Cru in 2012.

2015 was a remarkably uniform, generous vintage for the vines. The exceptional Côte Pavie terroir was no exception. One of the keys to this vintage with its particularly dry early summer was to keep an eye on water conservation, notably by repeating some ordinary soil work normally done in autumn or early spring.

In the winery, our maturing wines are subtle, calming and harmonious. 500L barrels are now in their rightful place.

Terroir: limestone-clay plateau on asteriated limestone, southfacing terraces – very shallow loamy clay soils on asteriated limestone, limestone-clay colluvial soils on hillsides

Vineyard area: 11,15 ha (9 in production)

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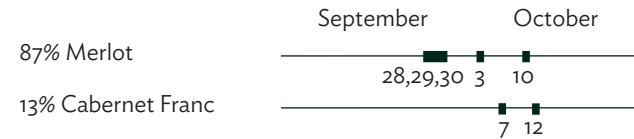
