



## SITE

The Grand Enclos is a 55-hectare walled vineyard, first cultivated in 1604. Situated in the northernmost part of the Saint-Julien appellation, the land rises to form two mounds that slope down to the Gironde estuary. The climate is moderated by a rare proximity to the river, which protects the vines from frost and has sculpted the site over millions of years.

## SOILS

Beneath the iconic white stone galets on the surface lies an extraordinary diversity of soil types that create a complex "Tetris" of interlocking layers. Among them is a significant proportion of treasured clay and gravel, with varying depths and degrees of compactness.

86% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Cabernet Franc, 4% Merlot
