

CHATEAU LASCOMBES 2010

- A very deep, brilliant black colour.
- ◆ Discreet at first on the nose before an explosion of black fruit aromas as the glass is swirled. A superb assortment of very ripe black fruits, such as blackberries and sun-drenched bigarreau cherries intermixed with chocolate and mocha notes. Great complexity and lots of finesse.
- ◆ The entry to the palate is fresh and sweet. All the wine's power and structure is counter-balanced by its round, fleshy texture and its lively, elegant flavours. Underneath a velvet wrapping the fullness of the wine comes through immediately together with fine-grained, tight-knit tannins, that are characteristic of the 2010 vintage. Black fruit flavours and spices come to the fore, followed by an incredibly long finish.

The 2010 Château Lascombes is a perfect example of a wine that combines complexity and power with elegance.
