The 2017 Phélan Ségur is **powerful**, ... **intense**, but also has more than enough fruit to stand up to the tannins. Dark red/purplish fruit, smoke, incense, charcoal embers and gravel give the wine much of **its distinctive savory/earthy personality**. Time in the glass brings out a more floral, red-toned quality that is **hugely appealing**. **Phélan Ségur has the potential to be one of the dark horses of 2017. Certainly, this is a very strong showing relative to the vintage and where Phélan has been in the recent past**. In 2017, the Grand Vin contains an unusually high amount of Cabernet Sauvignon (65%), much of which was able to hang until early October, with 34% Merlot and 1% Cabernet Franc. Winemaker Fabrice Bacquey opted to reduce exposure to oxygen during fermentation with the goal of maintaining as much freshness in the fruit as possible. Tasted two times. vinous

Château Phélan Ségur 2017 :

The 2017 Phélan-Ségur, was harvested as late as possible, starting on 14 September with the Merlot and starting the Cabernet around 27 September and finished around mid-October. It is matured in 50% new oak. It appears to **show more red fruit on the nose than its Saint-Estèphe peers**, just a little disjointed at first but melding together with time, raspberry and briary scents mixed with dried rose petals. The palate is medium-bodied with grippy tannin, quite foursquare and masculine, needing more flesh to come through on the finish.

Château Phélan Ségur 2017 :

91-93

From a 70 hectare vineyard, planted at an impressive 10,000 vines per hectare, comes this Cabernet dominated cuvee. The fruit was picked from September 14th through to October 4th, and the chosen blend is 65% Cabernet Sauvignon, with 34% Merlot and a tiny 1% contribution from the Cabernet Franc. The overall yield was 45 hl/ha, which fits with the absence of frost in this appellation.

It has a dark, robust, richly desiccated fruit character on the nose. The palate is full, grippy and fresh, with a pile of **bright tannin** beneath it all. **A solidly composed style**, a very **serious contender**, with toasted fruit, praline, cigar and tobacco oak, all sitting on a **bed of ripe and velvety tannins. A rich and imposing style**, typical of St Estèphe, **with good potential**.

The merchants' favourite ten wines expected to be released at under £500 per case were ranked as above. Grand Puy Lacoste took the top spot for the eighth year in a row. In second place was Langoa Barton. James Suckling described the wine as "serious for the vintage" and awarded it 93-94 points.
