54% Sémillon - 46% Sauvignon

Significant rainfall from November to February completely restored groundwater reserves, which had already been substantially replenished by average or higher than average rain in 2012 and 2013.

Bud break was early, followed by uniform flowering during the first week of June, spurred on by a rise in temperatures. As always, the impact of the weather on the vineyard was our primary concern, and our teams worked throughout the year to ensure that the grapes reach maturity in perfect health.

Yields were not very generous, but it's what's in the glass that counts!

TASTING NOTES (AT BOTTLING)

Superb freshness and aromatic expression, especially from the Sauvignon, with its notes of boxwood perfectly integrated with very light woody notes from the barrel.

The Sémillon is more noticeable at the start, bringing length and solidity to this wine that should be drunk Young.
