

"The 2021 Puygueraud offers light brambly blackberry and bilberry scents on the nose, which is more low-key than recent vintages, though well-defined. The palate is medium-bodied with soft tannins, nice piquancy, clean, pure fruit and an open-knit finish. This will provide pleasurable early drinking over 5-7 years."
