The Wine Doctor, Chris Kissack – 93-95 pts (2022/05)

« This property has put together a 2021 comprised of 57% sauvignon blanc and 43% Semillon, featuring notes of waxed white peach on the nose, wrapped up in layers of delicate toast and a herby, chamomille, minty freshness. The palate is very precise and compactly built, with saline, mineral and citrus elements, quite firm and taut in its construct, with littler seams of juicy fruit and a great thrust of charged minerals and acidity. Top work, but this is one that is definitely built for the cellar. A delicious result. Tasted twice. »

James Suckling – 92-93 pts (2022/05)

« Fresh and crisp with green apple, nettle, pineapple and gooseberry. A hint of white pepper, too. Medium-bodied with a vibrant finish. »

Vinous, Neil Martin – 91-93 pts (2022/05)

« The 2021 Latour-Martillac blanc has a knockout nose with apple blossom, nettle, wet pavement and citrus peel aromas. Real energy here. The palate is well balanced with fine concentration, taut and fresh with plenty of extract, touches of spice emerge towards the finish. Excellent. 2026-2048 »

The Wine Cellar Insider, Jeff Leve – 93 pts (2022/05)

« Honeysuckle, orange rind, lemon peel, flowers, green apples, and pineapple create the enticing perfume. Juicy, crisp, fresh, and creamy on the palate, with a sweetness to the yellow citrus along with crisp freshness in the finish. Drink from 2023-2033. »

Jancis Robinson – 15.5+ (2022/05)

« Broad, ripe nose. Quite focused, sharp acidity. This needs to settle down. Pretty hard work at the moment! Not much follow through. 2025-2030 »

Vinous, Antonio Galloni – 90-91 pts (2022/05)

« The 2021 Latour-Martillac Blanc offers an intriguing interplay of tension and fruit intensity. Lemon confit, marzipan, dried flowers, chamomile and mint come together effortlessly in the glass. Semillon adds quite a bit of texture. 2023-2030 »

The Wine Advocate – 89-91 pts (2022/05)

« Aromas of citrus oil, crisp orchard fruit and pastry cream introduce the 2021 Latour-Martillac blanc, a medium-bodied, bright and incisive wine that's performing well this year. »

Decanter, Georgina Hindle – 93 pts (2022/04)

« A crystalline aspect to the nose, real clarity and freshness. The palate is striking, zesty and alive, sharp yet also with density that gives a push-pull from the acidity and succulence. This is characterful, certainly full of life and flavour with a touch of sberbet sourness and honeyed snitness. Lots to like here, with a directness on the palate and a certain tension despite the range of flavours. This will have fans. 2025-2035 »

« This wine artfully softens its body through the salty mineral notes in a vintage with high-acidity, a magical experience similar to taming a tequila shot with lemon and salt. Delicate flavors of fennel, pars seed, and daisy fill my palates with vigor and fresh elegance. Profound mineral notes hidden among that of orange peels really catch me, leading me into a mistrial world. Strongly recommended. »

« Pale lemon yellow. Peach, apples, lemons, minerals nose. Fresh acidity, fruit driven and nuanced. Fresh acidity, apples, peach, nuanced, refreshing and long. »

« Touches of grated ginger, this is fresh, powerful and intense, with slate, white pear and apricot, stretches out through the palate, great quality, Tasted twice. »

RVF – 92-94 pts (2022/05)

« De ce blanc intense et discret (57 % sauvignon, 43 % sémillon) se dégage une très belle énergie. Il y a beaucoup de tension au cœur même d'un fruit pur, sobre mais possédant un vrai relief. On retrouve le grand style Latour-Martillac dans ce premier millésime intégralement vinifié par Édouard Kressmann, un blanc de haute tenue, sans esbrouffe aucune, qui s'inscrit dans la durée. »
