

Château Sociando-Mallet 2024 Haut-Médoc

Vineyard

49 hectares in production "Terroir" of gravel and clay over a clay-limestone sub-soil.
Grape varieties: 55% Merlot, 43% Cabernet Sauvignon and 2% Cabernet Franc.
Average age of the vines: 22 years

Density of plantation: 8 333 plants /ha

Vine growing methods and harvesting

Traditional ploughing Mindful soil improvement No spraying against botrytis

Vinification and ageing

Manual harvesting in small crates, from September 24^{th} to October 4^{th} , with manual sorting of the grapes before and after de-stemming. Classical wine making, in temperature-controlled concrete and stainless steel vats. Malolactic fermentation in vats. Ageing in 80% new oak barrels for 12 months.
