Château Lanessan 2019

BLEND: 54 % Cabernet Sauvignon, 36 % Merlot, 10 % Petit Verdot

SOIL: 32 hectares of vines planted in a bigger one-plot of 80 hectares. Deep Garonne gravel soil and a gravely and clayey subsoil.

HARVEST PERIOD: September 23RD to October 12th, 2019

VINTAGE:

- Mild and dry winter
- Intense heat from Mid-June, July and August. Strong sunshine
- Dried summer
- Sunny and dried September with medium temperature
- Diseases resistant vintage. Healthy state of harvest
- Perfect and aromatic berries with excellent phenolic compound

WINEMAKING PROCESS:

- Machine harvest with grapes selection by optical screening
- Fermentations and macerations in coated concrete tanks with temperature control system

AGING:

- 12 months in new French oak 225 liters barrels
- Medium intensity but long barrel toasting
- 1/3 new wood, 1/3 one-year old barrels and 1/3 two-year old barrels.

TASTING PROFILE:

Purple colour. Intense and clean nose, dominated by black cherry notes, candied black fruit with floral nuances, rose and violet. A rich and lively attack on the palate with very silky tannins, sweet and savoury. Lingering and fresh finish showing off powdered, candied, mineral nuances. Well-balanced wine, powerfull and fleshy.
