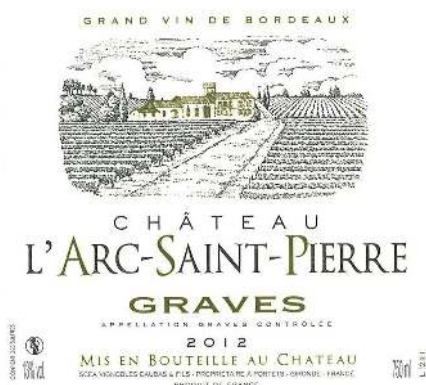




Château L'Arc Saint Pierre 2011

It was thanks to traditional boat that quarried stones were transported through the Garonne, in order to build the famous crenellated tower. Patrick Daubas, who comes from the 5th generation, operates his passion connecting a savoir-faire transmitted by his family and the modern oenologist techniques.

Bordeaux Tradition

This wine has a clear nose with ripe red and black berries. There is a beautiful long aroma with crunchy tannins, an oaky taste still young and present. It is a gourmet wine which could be quickly affordable.

Why buy this wine ?

- An authentically vineyard culture. The whole work is manual realized for the precision of a culture that has to be the most qualitative possible.
- Traditional vinification is followed by a rigorous and selective blending of wines.
- The whole property is vinified by hand in order to avoid any grape oxidation or crushing.
- Its grape variety, its terroir nature, its advised care to culture, this domain products a high quality wine.
