Château Barrail Meyney is located in the township of Genissac between the Garonne and the Dordogne river at ten kilometers from Libourne near Saint-Emilion. The hard work done by the ESBEN family in the wine making process is one of the reasons why Bordeaux Tradition has been working with this estate for many years. The wines produced are always of a high quality whatever the vintage is.

Bordeaux Tradition

The color is crimson, the nose is jamy with marked aromas of ripe red fruits. The wine's attack is lively and the body is full. The tannins are mellow and rich. The final mouth is long with a toasted sensation. This bottle is an enchantment for the pallet and can be drunk straight away or in the 5 years. The quality of the merlots in 2012 was very good.
