Château Bellecroix is located thirteen kilometers from Bordeaux on the right bank of the Garonne river. The estate is part of the family wine-farm Chateau Haut-Calens. In 1879, the owner was honored of a gold medal for the quality of this wine. Late 1970's Albert YUNG, the new owner of the estate, decided to reconstruct the vineyard and cellars entirely at his arrival at the head of the estate. This one was re-built in a more modern way.
