Château Bellecroix is located thirteen kilometers from Bordeaux on the left bank of the Garonne river in the famous Graves area. The estate is part of the family winefarm Chateau Haut-Calens.

In 1879, the owner was honored of a gold medal for the quality of this wine. Late 1970's Albert YUNG, the new owner of the estate, decided to reconstruct the vineyard and cellars entirely at his arrival at the head of the estate. This one was rebuilt in a more modern way.
