



Vineyard

On the Magdelaine plateau, stone's throw away from the village between Ausone and Angéus, Berliquet is one of the oldest Saint-Emilion vineyards.

Patrick de Lesquen and his son Jérôme make every effort to establish the reputation of the chateau. Nicolas Thienpont took over the chateau in 2008, assisted by his son Cyrille.

Berliquet is declaring its unique identity: a refined expression of limestone in the sun, aromatic brilliance with a level of discipline in the structure and texture, chalky with a distinctive saline finish.

Terroir: shallow limestone-clay plateau over asteriated limestone, clay on western side from Fronsac molasses, supplemented with shelves of limestone-clay colluvial deposits and Aeolian sand

Vineyard area: 9 ha (8,5 ha in production)
