

LA MISSION HAUT-BRION WHITE

An extreme rarity reserved for connoisseurs

Sought after by wine lovers the world over, Château La Mission Haut-Brion white is extremely rare (400 cases per vintage). Formerly named Château Laville Haut-Brion, the Château La Mission Haut-Brion white is a wine for connoisseurs.

This wine is a beautiful pale yellow in color with glints of green. The first nose of this wine is marked by the beautiful maturity of fruit that is ripe without heaviness. When swirled in the glass, the Sémillon dominates, accompanied by notes of lime. The first expression is broad and flavorful, leading into a more complex fullness, balanced by a discreet but highly effective acidity, with a surprisingly long finish. This La Mission vintage will continue to improve with a few

With its perfectly ripe Sémillons, 2019 is the model of a La Mission Blanc in its prime, combining the sun-drenched character of 2015 with a very nice freshness.

ASSEMBLAGE 2019

30.1% sauvignon blanc 69.9% sémillon

Estimated label alcohol degree: 14%

Harvested from August 30th to September 10th

LA CLARTÉ

The expression of Sémillon in a dry white wine of great finesse

This second white wine is common to Châteaux Haut-Brion and La Mission Haut-Brion. Produced by blending the second wines of the two estates, the Clarté de Haut-Brion is made from the sémillon and sauvignon grape varieties (about 1000 cases per vintage). A very nice first introduction before discovering its elders.

The wine is pale yellow in color. The first nose is moderately intense, slowly revealing itself when swirled in a glass, with the sauvignon subtly coming through, offset with aniseed and spicy notes. On the palate, the wine moves forward, tremendously delicate and fragrant, and then thickens, revealing a full body and a beautiful acidity. White flowers dominate the lingering aftertaste of the aromas. A superb wine to drink young.

This is the first example of a Clarté where the sauvignon Blanc dominates, which makes it very difficult to compare with previous vintages. With its incredible expression of fruit, it is unique!

Starting with the 2009 vintage, the La Mission Haut-Brion's second white wine was renamed La Clarté de Haut-Brion. Previous vintages carry the name Les Plantiers du Haut-Brion.

51.7% sauvignon 48.3% sémillon

Estimated label alcohol degree: 13.5%

Harvested from August 29th to September 10th
