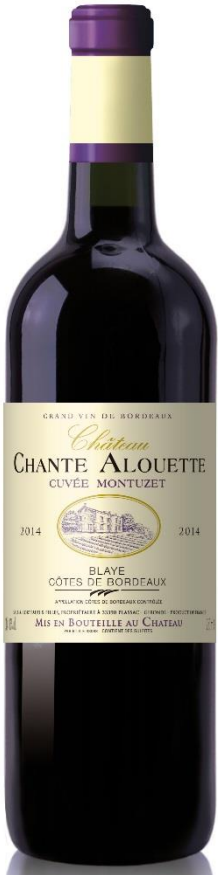




# Château Chante Alouette 2014 – Cuvée Montuzet

*Blaye – Côtes de Bordeaux*



Owned by the same family since 1900, this estate is managed by Mary-Pierre de Boissesson, great great-granddaughter of the creator of the vineyard. Overlooking Garonne's estuary & mainly facing due South, the 25ha of vines (average 30 years old) produces well balanced wines, often praised by the French guides (Hachette etc...).

## Bordeaux Tradition

At the first glance, the color jumps out at you, eventually backed by the high % of Malbec in the blend. Then the fruit comes and proudly shows its Right bank affiliation. The elegant structure and the freshness finally bring a superb balance
