

## Château Chante Alouette 2015 - Cuvée Montuzet

Blaye – Côtes de Bordeaux



Owned by the same family since 1900, this estate is managed by Mary-Pierre de Boisseson, great great-granddaughter of the creator of the vineyard. Overlooking Garonne's estuary & mainly facing due South, the 25ha of vines (average 30 years old) produces well balanced wines, often praised by the French guides (Hachette etc...).

At the first glance, the color jumps out at you, eventually backed by the high % of Malbec in the blend. Then the fruit comes and proudly shows its Right bank affiliation. The elegant structure and the freshness finally bring a superb balance
