This family estate has belonged to the DESPLAT family for more than three generations. Château La Clide is located on one of the highest points of the Gironde region at 100 meters of altitude. The estate is superb and favorable to vine growing due to its exposition. Since 1989, Château La Clide completes the estates range.

The work done in the vineyard and cellars is very traditional with a know-how that has been transmitted from generation to generation. The installations are very modern: thermo-regulated vats, air conditioning in the cellars, a reception room for visitors etc.
