

## La Dame Blanche 2010

*Haut-Médoc*



Château La Dame Blanche is the 2<sup>nd</sup> wine of Château Taillan (cru bourgeois Supérieur en 2003). This 150 ha familial property is the Cruse family cradle since 1896, located in Bordeaux, on the Haut Médoc appellation.

The estate lasts from 18<sup>th</sup> century; chais and tank are classified as historic monuments. Red vines extend on 22 ha; these in whites on 4 ha commercialized under the name of Château La Dame Blanche.

### **Bordeaux Tradition**

Wine have a deep and dark colors. Nose is open with ripe red berries notes. Attack is strong, warm and full of charm. Wine are silky with a lasting structure and acidity which gives a fine freshness. One of the best vintage of the property. propriété !
