Château La Dame Blanche is the 2nd wine of Château Taillan (cru bourgeois Supérieur en 2003). This 150 ha familial property is the Cruse family cradle since 1896, located in Bordeaux, on the Haut Médoc appellation.

The estate lasts from 18th century; chais and tank are classified as historic monuments. Red vines extend on 22 ha; these in whites on 4 ha commercialized under the name of Château La Dame Blanche.
