



# Dame Blanche 2014

*Haut Médoc*



Château La Dame Blanche is the second label of Ch. du Taillan (superior first growth in 2003). This familial estate of 150 yields is the Cruse family's cradle since 1896. Located near Bordeaux (in the Taillan) on the Haut-Médoc appellation.

The estate was built in the XVIII century, the wineries and the fermenting room are classified historical monuments. The red vines extends on 22 hectares, and the white vines on 4 yields, commercialized under the name Château la Dame Blanche.

## **Bordeaux Tradition**

The wines are showing a dark and intense color. The nose is open, with hints of mature red fruits. The attack is powerful, warm, and full of charm; the wines are silky with a structure support by a great acidity, which gives it a good coolness. One of the best vintage of the estate.
