HISTORY

The Thomas family has been winegrowers for several generations at Château Reverdi, located in Donissan, whose land is reputed to have been the first to be cultivated in Listrac.

Château Croix de Reverdi is not strictly speaking a second wine of Château Reverdi (regularly Cru Bourgeois and awarded), but a wine in its own right, produced from plots of land overlooking the Garonne, in the commune of Cussac. The work in the vineyard has been completely restructured since 1985 with drainage and plants adapted to the terroir.

Château Croix de Reverdi has been certified HVE level 3 since 2015. The HVE standard was set up following the Grenelle de l'Environnement. It is based not on objectives of means but on objectives of results.

THE TASTING

With a ruby hue, this wine reveals notes of cherry, English candy and spices. Its palate blends delicacy and tannins of high quality.

The finish is very precise, evoking in turn small forest gourmet fruits and subtle smoky notes.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Grape varieties : 50 % Merlot, 40 % Cabernet Sauvignon & 10 % Petit Verdot

Soil: Garonne gravel and clay-limestone

Ageing : Traditionnal ageing for 12 months in oak
